# LICENSE FOR REUSE OF METEOROLOGICAL INFORMATION UNDER THE FRENCH CODE OF RELATIONS BETWEEN THE PUBLIC AND THE ADMINISTRATION<sup>1</sup>

## EDUCATION OR RESEARCH LICENSE

**Processus de rattachement** \*: SPB-ESC1

**Portée principale** \*: users of public data entered in the public data catalogue of Météo-France

### Preamble

Météo-France is a State public administrative body, located 73, avenue de Paris, 94165 SAINT-MANDE CEDEX, France.

This license concerns a reuse within the context of a research or education activity.

### Article 1. Definitions

In this license the following words shall have the following meanings:

The term "Licensee" means the user who accepted this license.

The term "Information" means the meteorological information contained on the quotation that is accepted by the user.

The term "Reuse" means the use by Licensee of all or part of the Information for purposes other than the initial purpose within the public task for which the Information was generated or received by Météo-France. Reuse is performed within the framework of Title II of Book III of the CRPA. It must comply with the purposes set out in Article 3 below.

Re-distribution of the Information without transformation is one of the public tasks for which the Information was generated or received by Météo-France and is therefore not considered as Reuse.

Consequently, re-distribution of the Information without transformation is not authorized by this license.

"Research Activity" means any project organized by a university, a scientific research institute or similar (private or institutional), for non-commercial research purposes only. A necessary condition for the recognition of non-commercial purposes is that all the results obtained are openly available at delivery costs only, without any delay linked to commercial objectives, and that the research itself is submitted for open publication.

1 Code des relations entre le public et l'administration (CRPA)

“Education Activity” means any use of meteorological data by a school, university, scientific institute or similar (private or institutional), solely for educational purposes, without transmission or redistribution of these data, products and services to any further third party, or use of them to generate a value added service.

## **Article 2. Scope of this license**

The scope of this license is to lay down the conditions for Reuse of the Information by the Licensee, according the purposes defined in Article 3 below.

## **Article 3. Purposes of Reuse of the Information**

The Licensee is authorized to use the Information solely for the needs of the Research Activity or the Education Activity.

The Licensee cannot transfer the Information to a third party in any form. He cannot deliver to a third party, with or without charge, value added products or services derived from the Information governed by this license.

## **Article 4. Provision of the Information**

Météo-France provides the Information to the Licensee as-is, such as held by Météo-France as part of its public service task.

Météo-France is committed to make available to the Licensee the Information within a reasonable time depending on the state of the art. However, this period may be extended to one month from the date of order. It can be extended by another month if the number requests or the complexity thereof so warrant. The provision of the Information is carried out subject to availability and without prejudice to cases of force majeure in which Météo-France is unable to honor this commitment.

According to the CRPA, Météo-France is not obliged to take action on excessive requests.

## **Article 5. Intellectual Property Rights**

The Information is owned by Météo-France or organizations linked to it. Météo-France and, where appropriate, these organizations are the only holders of copyright in the Information and of property rights on databases containing the Information. In no case shall these rights be transferred to Licensee.

## **Article 6. Obligations of the Licensee**

The Licensee is responsible for the fulfilment of his obligations under this license even if it has entrusted them to a third party.

The Licensee shall not use the Information for purposes other than those provided by this license without the prior written consent of Météo-France. In particular, the transfer to any person or entity is strictly forbidden.

The Licensee shall indicate clearly “Météo-France” as provider of the Information in publications resulting from the Research Activity or Education Activity.

In case of Research Activity, the Licensee shall provide Météo-France with a copy of the Research Activity report, once completed.

The Licensee commits to delete the Information once the Research Activity or Education Activity is completed, or at the latest one year after the end of validity of this license.

## **Article 7. Financial Terms**

### **7.1. Case of Information delivered to the Licensee via the Météo-France Public Data Online Ordering Tool**

Information is delivered to the Licensee free of charge.

### **7.2. Case of Information delivered to the Licensee via another mean**

Information is delivered to the Licensee against payment of a fee, which corresponds to delivery costs only. A fee is so payable by the Licensee for each order. The amount is specified in the quotation submitted to the acceptance of the Licensee. Reuse of the Information by the Licensee shall be subject to payment of the fee.

## **Article 8. Responsibility**

**8.1.** In case of breach by the Licensee of any of its obligations, the matter will be brought before the competent courts.

In addition, the Licensee may be fined by the French Commission on Access to Administrative Documents up to two million euros, pursuant to Article L326-1 of the CRPA. The Licensee may also be forbidden to reuse any public sector information produced or received not only by Météo-France but also by the State, local authorities, other public bodies, or private parties having a public service mission.

**8.2.** Météo-France will not be liable for events arising from the interpretation or use of the Information provided.

Météo-France will not be liable for any failure to fulfill its obligations in the event of force majeure. Are considered as force majeure: war, riot, total or partial strikes, whether internal or external to Météo-France, failures and destruction of electronic or mechanical equipment, breakdown of means of transport and communications, severe weather, earthquakes, fires, storms, floods, water damage, requisitions or laws or regulations imposing restrictions as regards to this license or to freedom of movement, as well as circumstances used in French case law on these matters.

## **Article 9. Termination**

Where the Licensee – or the Subsidiary which has benefited from the Information – has materially breached its obligations, formal notice shall be considered to be a registered letter addressed to the Licensee with return receipt. Where the formal notice has been ineffectual on the expiry of a period of one month from the date of receipt, Météo-France may terminate this license.

The Licensee may terminate this license at any time.

#### **Article 10. Effects of termination of this license**

In the event that this license were to be terminated, for any reason whatsoever, Météo-France shall cease to provide the Licensee with the Information. If this license has been accepted by creating an account on Météo-France Public Data Online Ordering Tool, the account shall be deleted. Except in cases of termination as a result of Licensee material breach of this license, Licensee may continue to use the Information made available prior to the termination for an unlimited period. Obligations attached to Reuse shall survive the termination of this license for an unlimited period.

#### **Article 11. Transfer of this license to third parties**

Any transfer of this license is prohibited, including in the case of transfer of assets of the Licensee to a new or existing entity.

#### **Article 12. Duration**

This license is valid for one year once accepted by the Licensee.

#### **Article 13. Modifications**

Météo-France reserves the right to adapt or modify at any time the terms of this license.

#### **Article 14. Acceptance of this License**

This license, as well as the Terms of Use of Météo-France Public Data Online Ordering Tool set out in Article 4 above, shall be considered accepted by the Licensee when signing the application form for Météo-France public data for education or research.
